What can be recycled?

All plastic must be clean, dry, and free of food residue.



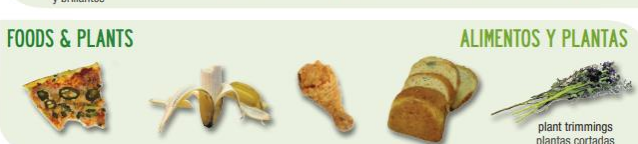
Don't forget to use your reusable bags!

- ✓ Office Paper
- ✓ Envelopes (no Tyvek, reinforced fiber, or padded envelopes)
- ✓ Magazines & Catalogs
- ✓ Newspapers & Inserts
- ✓ Telephone Books
- ✓ Post-It Notes
- ✓ Junk Mail (unopened OK)
- ✓ Paperback Books
- ✓ Soft Cover Manuals
- ✓ Hard Cover Books
- ✓ File Folders
- ✓ White/Pastel Packing Paper (no tissue paper)
- ✓ White Boxboard or Card Stock
- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ Cereal Boxes (remove inner packaging)
- ✓ Paper Bags or Other Brown Paper
- ✓ Gray Paperboard, Boxboard, Paperboard Egg Cartons
- ✓ Dark Colored Accordion Files
- ✓ Milk Cartons
- ✓ Juice Boxes
- ✓ Plastic Bottles, Jars, Jugs, and Tubs (#1, 2, & 5)
 - Note: The chasing arrows symbol doesn't mean it's recyclable. Follow the SHAPE guidelines first, then the number.
- ✓ Bottle Caps (left on the container or loose)
- ✓ Plastic Coffee Containers
- ✓ Margarine & Yogurt Containers
- ✓ Aluminum Cans
- ✓ Metal Cans
- ✓ Glass Bottles & Containers (no window glass or ceramics)
