## DUST CONTROL APPLICATION AND PROCEDURES PERMIT

Residents of Jackson County may apply dust control, at their own expense, on Jackson County roads under the following conditions:

- The dust control product and application rate must be approved by the County Maintenance Staff prior to application to assure it doesn't leave a slippery or slimy surface on the county road after a rain event. (Calcium Chloride and Magnesium Chloride are the most commonly used dust control products in Jackson County).
- The dust control product must be applied in suitable weather conditions.
- Jackson County Maintenance Staff must be notified prior to applying any dust control product on a county road with enough advance warning that the county has a chance to adequately grade the road prior to the application of the dust control product.

After the dust control is applied, Jackson County will minimize the amount of grading to the area of applied dust control. However, residents need to be aware that for the safety of the traveling public, Jackson County maintains the right, and has the sole discretion to decide if, when, and how much grading is needed. Such grading may be done without notification to residents.

Occasionally, the County must re-gravel sections of roadway which means the dust control treatment may be covered up making it less effective. Jackson County again has sole discretion in deciding when and where gravel needs to be added to a road. Adding gravel to any road surface will be done without notification to residents.

### **Jackson County will not be liable for any costs associated with the reapplication of dust control product for any reason.**

If an additional application is needed within the same calendar year, the above conditions must be met again, including notifying Jackson County prior to the application. A new permit application will not be needed.

Permit is only good for the calendar year in which it was issued.

**Any chemical or dust control measures placed on a county road without prior approval of the Jackson County Public Works Department and/or not meeting any of the above conditions will be graded over by the Public Works Department and the parties involved could be subject to a misdemeanor and possible fines under Minnesota Statute 160.2715.**
