

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE JACKSON COUNTY DRAINAGE AUTHORITY, JACKSON  
COUNTY, MINNESOTA  
ADOPTED**

**June 16, 2020**

Present: Commissioners Scott McClure, Jim Eigenberg, Phil Nasby, Cathy Hohenstein, and Don Wachal, Kevin Nordquist, Sherry Haley, Tim Stahl, Dave Macek, Heather Hummel.

Chair McClure called the Jackson County Drainage Authority Meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Commissioner Wachal motioned to approve the agenda. Commissioner Hohenstein seconded. Motion carried. Commissioner Eigenberg motioned to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Nasby seconded. Motion carried.

Item 3.1 – We are getting close to the amount that was bonded but there is savings to be had. In regards to County Ditch 125, Judicial Ditch 18 dumps into it. The newer ditch is CD 125. They are looking at eliminating crossing and adding a driveway with easement instead of having crossings (ditch law allows this). By eliminating road crossings and ditch crossing you are saving around \$80,000 per ditch crossing. The Change Order will explain why the changes and how CD 125 and JD 18 is all connected. It has been recommended at the final hearing to make this all one ditch so that it is less confusing. The three projects would be assessed separately to parcels but then the maintenance would be as one ditch if the drainage authority passed the resolution to make it one combined ditch.

There will be a change to the viewers report as there is approximately 1,100 foot that will be farmable for the Hauge Family. Will ask Mr. Ringquist to update the viewers report before final hearing. Will also need a complete viewer report with all three ditches combined. There will also be a final informational meeting before the final hearings.


There is some concern of some landowners with going outside of the watershed. This will be mentioned/warned at the information meeting.
