

PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

June 13, 2022

The County Board of Equalization of Jackson, Minnesota met in the Jackson County Government Resource Center, Cafeteria, Door 7, 402 White Street, City of Jackson, Minnesota, on June 13, 2022. The following members were present: Commissioner, James Eigenberg; Commissioner, Catherine Hohenstein; Commissioner, Scott McClure; Commissioner, Phil Nasby; Commissioner, Don Wachal; and Auditor/Treasurer, Kevin Nordquist. County Administrator, Ryan Krosch; County Assessor, Karla Ambrose and Assistant to the Administrator, Brandi Bourquin were also in attendance.

The Board of Equalization completed an oath to fairly and impartially perform their duties.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair Hohenstein called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wachal and seconded by Commissioner McClure to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statute 274.135 there must be at least one member at each meeting of a county board of appeal and equalization who has attended an appeals and equalization course developed or approved by the Commissioner of Revenue within the last four years. Commissioners Eigenberg, Hohenstein, McClure, Nasby and Wachal have completed the training and are currently certified.

County Assessor, Karla Ambrose presented the 2022 assessment review.

There were no scheduled appeals and no members of the public in attendance for unscheduled appeals or questions.

Motion was made by Commissioner Eigenberg and seconded by Commissioner Wachal to adopt the revised valuation of parcel 03.026.0900 of \$67,800. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Commissioner McClure and seconded by Commission Nasby to adopt the revised valuation of parcel 07.020.0700 of \$21,500. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Commissioner Nasby and seconded by Commissioner Wachal to adopt the revised valuation of parcel 07.028.0800 of \$65,600. The motion carried unanimously.
