Based on previous action by your city council or town board, all elections held in conjunction with a federal, state, or county election are conducted exclusively by mail.

ELECTION BALLOTS WILL BE MAILED TO ALL REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE ABOVE NOTED PRECINCTS FOR EACH ELIGIBLE ELECTION. Local polling places in your city or township will not be open on Election Day.

For the **2024 General Election**, the election date is **Tuesday, November 5, 2024**. Ballots will be mailed to all registered voters in mail ballot precincts by Jackson County Elections between September 20, 2024 and October 22, 2024.

Each voter registered by 5:00 p.m. on October 15, 2024 for the Primary election will be mailed a ballot automatically. **The ballot mailed to you is your OFFICIAL BALLOT for that election.** Instructions for marking and returning the ballot for counting will be included in the mailing. Please note the instructions will require you to have a witness for voter certification at the time of completing your ballot.

Your ballot will be sent by non-forwardable mail; therefore a registered voter who will be absent from their permanent address during the mailing period and wants to receive their ballot at a temporary address must contact our office at the address, telephone number, or email address below and request an absentee ballot application; or complete an on-line absentee ballot application at <http://mnvotes.org>. If you normally receive your mail via PO Box and do not receive your ballot at your physical address, please contact our office before October 15, 2024.

Eligible voters who are not pre-registered by the dates noted above and wish to vote in the State Elections should contact our office at the address, telephone number, or email address below and request an absentee ballot application or complete an on-line absentee ballot application at <http://mnvotes.org>.

All ballots must be returned by mail (a prepaid postage return envelope is included when the ballots are mailed), in person or delivered by a designated agent to the address below prior to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day in order to be counted.

Ballots will be accepted Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. In addition to normal business hours, we will be open Saturday, October 26, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 29th, 2024 from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m., Saturday, November 2, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., Sunday, November 3, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and Monday, November 4, 2024 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The in-person polling place for Mail Ballot Precincts will be at the Jackson County Courthouse. This combined polling place will be open on Tuesday, November 5, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

At least one assistive voting ballot marker will be available at the courthouse that permits people with disabilities to vote privately and independently and that permit any voter to submit their ballot to be automatically checked and corrected for voting errors prior to being cast and counted.

All mail ballots will be counted after 8:00 p.m. on November 5, 2024 at the Jackson County Courthouse in the Jackson County Auditor/Treasurer's Office.
