

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF JACKSON COUNTY, MINNESOTA
SPECIAL MEETING (BUDGET WORK SESSION)**

August 31, 2020

The County Board of Jackson County met in special session to review and discuss the Fiscal Year 2021 Jackson County budget, in the Jackson County Government Resource Center, Cafeteria Room (Door 7), 402 White Street, City of Jackson, Minnesota, on August 31, 2020. The following members were present: Philip Nasby, Don Wachal, James Eigenberg, Cathy Hohenstein and Scott McClure, Commissioners. Also present were County Coordinator Steven Duncan, Deputy County Coordinator Trish Schulz, Auditor/Treasurer Kevin Nordquist and Chief Deputy Auditor/Treasurer-Fiscal Officer Jill Horn.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair McClure called the meeting to order at approximately 8:00 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Hohenstein and seconded by Commissioner Nasby to adopt the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board reviewed and discussed the Fiscal Year 2021 Jackson County draft budget. A preliminary levy of 3.62% was arrived at after said review and budget preparation discussion among the Board and staff. It was highlighted by staff that it was likely the levy could be reduced further prior to setting the final levy in December but urged that there were still a few outstanding issues to be evaluated for their impact on the budget (e.g., actual health insurance enrollment numbers).

Motion was made by Commissioner Eigenberg and seconded by Commissioner Wachal to adjourn the meeting at 9:41 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
