

PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF JACKSON COUNTY, MINNESOTA

January 13, 2020

The County Board of Jackson County, Minnesota met in special session, in the Jackson County Courthouse Board Room, 405 Fourth Street, City of Jackson, Minnesota, on January 13, 2020, for the purpose of the County Board discussing legislative issues with State Senator Julie Rosen.

The following County Board members were present: Don Wachal, Philip Nasby, Catherine Hohenstein, James Eigenberg and Scott McClure. County Coordinator Steven Duncan, County Assessor Jason McCaslin, County Auditor/Treasurer Kevin Nordquist, County Attorney Sherry Haley, and Senator Julie Rosen were also in attendance.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair McClure called the meeting to order at approximately 4:43 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Hohenstein and seconded by Commissioner Wachal to adopt the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

STATE SENATOR JULIE ROSEN

Minnesota State Senator Julie Rosen was in attendance and gave an overview of some of her legislative activities. Most of the meeting time was devoted to the County Board and staff highlighting the adopted Jackson County legislative platform positions of interest and engaging Senator Rosen in discussion about various County concerns and interests (e.g., County-based purchasing, bonding for trails, etc.). There was no Board action taken at this meeting. The Board thanked State Senator Rosen for her attending such a meeting.
