

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF JACKSON COUNTY, MINNESOTA
SPECIAL MEETING & BUDGET WORK SESSION**

NOVEMBER 19, 2020

The County Board of Jackson County met in special session to review and discuss the Fiscal Year 2021 Jackson County budget, in the Jackson County Government Resource Center, Cafeteria Room (Door 7), 402 White Street, City of Jackson, Minnesota, on November 19, 2020. The following members were present: Commissioners Don Wachal, James Eigenberg and Scott McClure. Also present were County Coordinator Steven Duncan, Deputy County Coordinator Trish Schulz, Auditor/Treasurer Kevin Nordquist and Chief Deputy Auditor/Treasurer-Fiscal Officer Jill Horn. Commissioners Catherine Hohenstein and Phillip Nasby were unable to attend.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair McClure called the meeting to order at approximately 8:00 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wachal and seconded by Commissioner Eigenberg to adopt the agenda. The motion carried with three “ayes”, no “nays” and two “absent” (Nasby, Hohenstein).

WORK SESSION

The Board spent meeting time reviewing and discussing the draft Fiscal Year 2021 Jackson County budget. A request from the Sheriff’s office to budget to provide cloud storage for squad car videos was presented and included in the budget. After said review and discussion, the proposed final levy was set to be considered at 1.75%.
